SALEM POLICE MAKE ARREST IN ROBBERY CASE

On Tuesday, September 6, the Salem Police Department was called to investigate an armed robbery at a business in the 100 block of Electric Road at 9:23 p.m. The victim reported that the suspect entered her place of employment just prior to closing.

The victim told police that the suspect produced a knife, removed currency from the cash register and then left the area on foot. The female employee was not injured during the incident.

Responding officers located the suspect in close proximity to the business at approximately 9:30 p.m. He has been identified as 18-year-old Terah C. Morris of Roanoke. Morris has been charged with robbery and providing false information to police to avoid arrest. He is being held without bond in the Roanoke County/Salem jail.
