SALEM POLICE PLACE ADDITIONAL CHARGES

On September 12, at approximately 2:00 p.m., Hung P. Nguyen was arrested by the Salem Police Department and charged with two counts of impersonating a police officer. These charges developed from the investigation of the sexual battery of a Roanoke College student.

On September 3, two students reported an encounter with a male suspect on N. Market Street. The suspect was inside of a vehicle when he attempted to gain the victims' attention by calling them to his car and telling them he was a police officer. The victims then reported the incident to Roanoke College Campus Safety.

Nguyen, who originally was arrested on September 11 and charged with sexual battery, has been released from the Roanoke County/Salem jail on an unsecured bond.
